### \* Confession of Faith: The Scots Confession of Faith of 1560, Chapter 8 (first half)

*The same Eternal God and Father, who of mere mercy elected us in Christ Jesus his Son before the foundation of the world was laid, appointed him to be our Head, our Brother, our Pastor, and great Bishop of our Souls. But because that the enmity between the justice of God and our sins was such, that no flesh by itself could or might have attained unto God, it behooved that the Son of God should descend unto us, and take himself a body of our body, flesh of our flesh, and bone of our bones, and so become the perfect Mediator between God and man, giving power to so many as believe in Him to be the sons of God as himself does witness, “I ascend to My Father and your Father, and My God and your God” by which most holy fraternity, whatsoever we have lost in Adam, is restored to us again.
