We believe and confess that there is but one God, spiritual, eternal, invisible, immutable, infinite, incomprehensible, ineffable, omnipotent, all-wise all-good, all-just, and all-merciful. There are three Persons: the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit.

God, who has all things in subjection to him, watches over us with a Father's care, so that not a hair of our heads shall fall without his will. And Yet he restrains the devils and all our enemies, so that they cannot harm us without his leave.

We believe that man was created pure and perfect in the image of God, and that by his own guilt he fell and is thus alienated from God, the fountain of justice and of all good, so that his nature is totally corrupt. And being blinded in mind, and depraved in heart, he has lost all integrity, and there is no good in him.
